Scope Summary Data and Reporting: Under this task Jacobs shall provide data and reporting support to conduct ongoing data analyses, expand and enhance reporting capabilities, and improve data quality and utilization related to the Customer Service Center system (CSC), the Roadway Toll System (RTS) lane systems, and WSDOT Tolling's own operations, oversight, and management activities.

Timeliness: Contract window: 10/1/14 through 9/30/15; this task initiates the second phase of data and reporting analysis.

Deliverables: Level of effort contract provides approximately 2 full-time equivalent of staff support. Deliverables are ongoing.

Extension/Time or Budget Amendment:

Task Y-11038-BQ

Scope Summary Data and Reporting: WSDOT has identified the CSC Systems and Operations Request for Proposal Support as a three phase approach. Phase 1 – Plan the Plan, what to procure, Phase 2-Development of Solicitation Material and Phase 3 – the Solicitation Process. Under this task Jacobs shall continue work on the phase elements described in task BQ as directed by the WSDOT Project Manager. Added emphasis will focus on gathering industry information and requirements, researching procurement methodology to support customer service center request for proposals for short and long term operators as well as a long term back office system.

Timeliness: Contract window: 5/1/14 through 1/31/15; the original task order, BQ-00 was for Phase 1 of the procurement – Plan the Plan – determining "What to Procure". Amendment 1 extended the time of the work effort from August 31, 2014 to December 31, 2014. Amendment 2 initiated Phase 2 of the procurement effort – Phase 2 – Development of Solicitation Material, specifically the CSC Short term operator, long term operator, and long term system requirements gathering and contract support. Continued effort will extend task BQ with planned execution next quarter.

Deliverables: Level of effort contract provides approximately 4 full-time equivalent of staff support. Deliverables for this task are ongoing.
