

# **Washington Prospective Teacher Assessment System:**

## **2007-2008 Results**

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## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Washington State Legislature, in creating the Professional Educator Standards Board (PESB), directed the PESB to establish a prospective teacher assessment system. This assessment system includes an assessment of basic skills in reading, mathematics and writing and an assessment of content knowledge of subjects that will be taught. The timeline established by law is for the basic skills test to be required of candidates beginning September 1, 2002 and the subject knowledge tests to be required for each teaching endorsement beginning September 1, 2005.

### **The Washington Educator Skills Test-Basic (WEST-B)**

The Professional Educator Standards Board established the Washington Educator Skills Test – Basic (WEST-B) as a requirement for admission to approved teacher preparation programs in Washington. The WEST-B is also required of persons from out-of-state seeking a Washington State residency teaching certificate.

The WEST-B measures basic skills in reading, mathematics, and writing through three subtests. Test objectives were developed for each subtest to be consistent with the Washington Essential Academic Learning Requirements (EALRs). The reading and mathematics subtests have 60 multiple choice questions each. On the writing subtest, examinees respond to 50 multiple choice questions and 2 writing prompts.

The WEST-B was administered for the first time in August of 2002. September 2008 marked the end of the sixth year of administration of the WEST-B as a requirement specified in RCW 28A.410.220. During this past year, the WEST-B has been given on six different dates at ten locations throughout the state.

- During the sixth year of administration a total of 4,860 prospective teachers took the WEST-B. Overall, there is a 28% decrease in examinees tested from 2002 to 2008.
- Of the 4,860 examinees who attempted at least 1 subtest in '07-'08, 75% passed all three on their first attempt. (75% in '06-'07, '05-'06 and '04-'05 test year; 79% '03-'04 and in '02-'03.) The initial passing rates were higher for the individual subtests with 94% of 4,733 examinees passing the reading subtest (94% in '06-'07; 95% in '05-'06 and '04-'05; 94% in '03-'04; and 94% in '02-'03), 94% of 4,642 examinees passing the mathematics subtest (94% in '06-'07; 93% in '05-'06 and '04-'05; 92% in '03-'04 and in '02-'03), and 87% of 4,597 examinees passing the writing subtest (88% in '05-'06; 86% in '04-'05; 83% in '03-'04; 84% in '02-'03). Table 1 provides the total number tested for the '07-'08 test year, plus initial passing rates for all examinees taking the WEST-B during the '07-'08 test year, along with the initial passing rates for each subtest for the examinees who indicated their ethnicity.

- Since examinees can retake WEST-B subtests, the cumulative passing rates are higher with 87% of the 4,860 examinees during the 2007-2008 test year eventually passing all three subtests (87% in '06-'07; 86% in '05-'06 and '04-'05; 88% in '03-'04; and 88% in '03-'02), 96% of 4,803 examinees eventually passing the reading subtest (96% in '06-'07 and '05-'06; 97% in '04-'05; 96% in '03-'04; 96% in '02-'03), 96% of 4,770 eventually passing the mathematics subtest (96% in '06-'07 and '05-'06; 95% in '04-'05; 95% in '03-'04; and 95% in '02-'03), and 92% of 4,746 eventually passing the writing subtest (93% in '06-'07; 92% in '05-'06 and '04-'05; 90% in '03-'04; 91% and in '02-'03).
- These cumulative pass rates results were also calculated for ethnic subgroups of examinees. Of the 43 American Indian/Alaskan Natives, 77% met the requirement (69% in '06-'07; 80% in '05-'06; 66% in '04-'05; 75% in '03-'04; and 80% in '02-'03). Of the 239 who identified themselves as Asian/Pacific Islander, 74% met the requirement (75% in '06-'07; 74% in '05-'06; 69% in '04-'05; 71% in '03-'04; and 73% in '02-'03). Of the 79 Black/African Americans, 58% met the requirement (60% in '06-'07; 63% in '05-'06; 58% in '04-'05; 62% in '03-'04; 68% in '02-'03). Of the 199 Hispanic examinees, 63% met the requirement (65% in '06-'07; 58% in '05-'06; 64% in '04-'05; 67% in '03-'04; and 70% in '02-'03). Of the 146 examinees multi-racial examinees, 88% met the requirement (89% in '06-'07; 84% in '05-'06; 83% in '04-'05; 89% in '03-'04; and 87% in '02-'03). Of the 3,714 examinees who identified themselves as White, 89% met the WEST-B requirement (89% in '06-'07, '05-'06 and '04-'05; 90% in '03-'04; and 90% in '02-'03). Of the 440 examinees who gave no response about their ethnicity, 90% met the requirement (88% in '06-'07; 89% in '05-'06; 92% in '04-'05; 92% in '03-'04; and 90% in '02-'03).

Note: Extreme caution should be used in interpreting data for small numbers (<100) of examinees. The examinees for whom results are presented in this document may not reflect the same proportion of all the types and capabilities of examinees in the population who will take the tests in the future. Cumulative passing rates for the WEST-B and for each subtest along with numbers of examinees for test year 2007-08 are provided in Table 2.

- 4,674 examinees attempted at least one subtest across all administrations during the previous 2006-07 test year. (1,111 were out-of-state applicants who indicated during registration that they attend or attended a college or university outside Washington State in response to a background question regarding the undergraduate college or university attended.) Of the 4,674 examinees tested in 2006-07, 4,348 (93%) passed all three subtests.
- Of the 34,729 examinees who took the reading subtest between August 2002 and August 2008, 94% passed on the initial attempt, and 98% passed by the third attempt.

- Of the 34,609 examinees who took the mathematics subtest between August 2002 and August 2008, 93% passed on the initial attempt, and 97% passed by the third attempt.
- Of the 34,570 examinees who took the writing subtest between August 2002 and August 2008, 86% passed on the initial attempt, and 95% passed by the third attempt.
- 3,079 candidates were admitted by the 21 institutions and five alternative routes to certification with PESB-approved teacher preparation programs in 2007-08. (This compares to 3,189 candidates were admitted by the 21 institutions in 2006-07; 3,509 candidates admitted by 22 institutions in 2005-06; 3,689 candidates admitted by 21 institutions in 2004-05, and 4,027 candidates admitted by 22 institutions in 2003-04.)
- Of 3,079 admitted candidates, 2,967 (96%) attempted all three subtests of the WEST-B at least once; 2,895 (94%) had completed the WEST-B requirement, and 184 (6%) had not completed the WEST-B requirement before August 31, 2007, the end of the 2007-08 test year.
- The percentages of admitted candidates who had not completed the WEST-B requirement by the end of the 2007-08 test year ranged from 0% to 22% among the teacher preparation institutions (0% to 23% in '06-'07 and '05-'06; 0% to 26% in '04-'05; 0%-33% in '03-'04). The statewide average is 6% (8% in '06-'07; 7% in '05-'06 and '04-'05; 5% in '03-'04).
- Of the 3,079 admitted candidates who attempted the reading subtest, 2,961 (99%) passed (98% passed in '06-'07; 99% passed in '05-'06, '04-'05 and '03-'04 test years). The mean score of passing candidates was 271 (270 in '06-'07; 272 in '05-'06 and in '04-'05; 273 in '03-'04) within a passing range of 240 to 300. (The same in '06-'07; '05-'06, '04-'05 and '03-'04).
- Of the 3,079 admitted candidates who attempted the mathematics subtest, 2,945 (99%) passed (98% passed in the '06-'07 and '05-'06 test years; 99% in the '04-'05 test year; 98% in '03-'04.) The mean score was 278 within a passing range of 240 to 300. (The mean was 277 in '06-'07; 276 in '05-'06, '04-'05 and 276 '03-'04).
- Of the 3,079 admitted candidates who attempted the writing subtest, 2,926 (98%) passed (96% passed in '06-'07; 98% in '05-'06 and '04-'05 test year; 97% passed in '03-'04). The mean score of passing candidates was 265 within a passing range of 240 to 300. (The mean score was 265 in '06-'07; 264 in '05-'06, '04-'05 and 265 in '03-'04).

## Washington Educator Skills Tests – Endorsements (WEST-E/Praxis II)

- RCW 28A.410.220 directs the PESB to implement content knowledge tests to be required of candidates applying for endorsements on the residency certificate. The test requirement was implemented on September 1, 2005. Test administration of the Praxis II tests, selected by the PESB for the use in Washington, took place at ten testing centers across the state on seven dates during the 2007-2008 test year. The state-wide number tested by the individual Praxis II exams range from 2 to 2,464 examinees. The pass rates range from 43% to 100% (72%-100% in '06-'07 and '05-'06) for the individual Praxis II tests.
- The passing percentages for six tests (three tests in 2006-07, four tests in 2005-06) were below 80%. Twenty one tests had passing percentages above 80%. One test had less than 5 examinees; therefore, passing percentages are not calculated.

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## **WASHINGTON PROSPECTIVE TEACHER ASSESSMENT SYSTEM: 2007-2008 RESULTS**

The Washington State Legislature, in creating the Professional Educator Standards Board (PESB), directed the PESB to establish a prospective teacher assessment system. This assessment system includes an assessment of basic skills in reading, mathematics and writing and an assessment of content knowledge of subjects that will be taught. The timeline established by the law is for the basic skills test to be required of candidates beginning September 1, 2002 and the subject knowledge tests to be required for each teaching endorsement beginning September 1, 2005.

### **Washington Educator Skills Test – Basic (WEST-B)**

Under this mandate, the PESB established the Washington Educator Skills Test – Basic (WEST-B) as a requirement for admission to approved teacher preparation programs in Washington. The WEST-B is also required of persons from out-of-state seeking a Washington State residency teaching certificate.

Since September of 2001 the PESB has worked with the WEST-B contractor National Evaluation Systems, Inc. (Now the Evaluation Systems group of Pearson) on the development and administration of this basic skills test of prospective teachers. The PESB closely supervises the development and implementation of the assessment program to ensure that it is in compliance with the legislative mandate, fully aligned with the Washington State policies and practices, and appropriate for verifying the basic skills knowledge of individuals seeking entry into the Washington State teaching force.

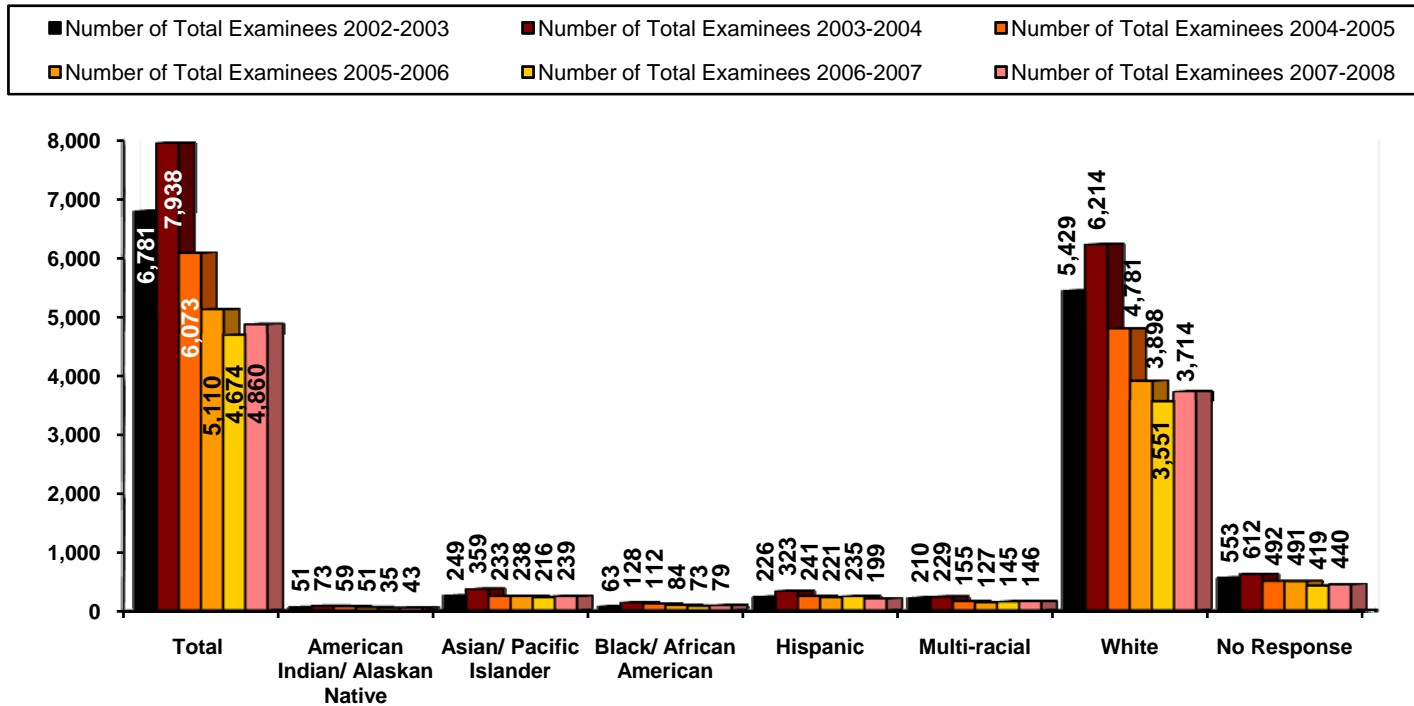
The WEST-B measures basic skills in reading, mathematics, and writing through three subtests. Test objectives were developed for each subtest to be consistent with the Washington Essential Academic Learning Requirements (EALRs). The reading and mathematics subtests have 60 multiple choice questions each. On the writing subtest, examinees respond to 50 multiple choice questions and 2 writing prompts. Test items and writing prompts were reviewed for content and fairness by Washington educators prior to being included on the WEST-B. The PESB adopted passing scores for each WEST-B subtest following the first test administration.

The WEST-B was administered for the first time in August of 2002. August 31, 2008 marked the end of the sixth year of administration of the WEST-B as a requirement specified in RCW 28A.410.220. During this past year the WEST-B has been given on six different dates at nine locations throughout the state.

## WEST-B Total Number of All Examinees by Ethnicity

During the sixth year of administration a total of 4,860 prospective teachers were tested. Figure 1 displays the total examinees for the sixth test years 2002-2008. Overall, there is a 28% decrease in examinees tested between 2002 to 2008. Of the 4,860 total WEST-B examinees 43 identified themselves as American Indian/Alaskan Native, 239 as Asian/Pacific Islander, 79 as Black/African American, 199 as Hispanic, 146 as multi-racial; 3,714 identified themselves as White, and 440 provided no response as to their ethnicity. Note: Designations for gender and ethnicity are based on examinee responses to a question on the registration form that is “optional.” Because some examinees did not respond to this question, the sum of examinees in the reporting groups may not equal the number of “Total Examinees.”

### **WEST-B Initial Pass Rates of All Examinees by Ethnicity**

Of the 4,860 examinees who attempted at least 1 subtest in '07-'08, 75% passed all three on their first attempt (75% in '06-'07, '05-'06 and '04-'05 test year; 79% '03-'04 and in '02-'03.) The initial passing rates were higher for the individual subtests with 94% of 4,733 examinees passing the reading subtest (94% in '06-'07; 95% in '05-'06 and '04-'05; 94% in '03-'04; and 94% in '02-'03), 94% of 4,642 examinees passing the mathematics subtest (94% in '06-'07; 93% in '05-'06 and '04-'05; 92% in '03-'04 and in '02-'03), and 87% of 4,597 examinees passing the writing subtest (88% in '05-'06; 86% in '04-'05; 83% in '03-'04; 84% in '02-'03). Table 1 provides the total number tested for the '07-'08 test year, plus initial passing rates for all examinees taking the WEST-B during the '07-'08 test year, along with the initial passing rates for each subtest for the examinees who indicated their ethnicity.

## WEST-B Cumulative Pass Rates of All Examinees by Ethnicity

Since examinees can retake WEST-B subtests, the cumulative passing rates are higher with 87% of the 4,860 examinees during the 2007-2008 test year eventually passing all three subtests (87% in '06-'07; 86% in '05-'06 and '04-'05; 88% in '03-'04; and 88% in '03-'02), 96% of 4,803 examinees eventually passing the reading subtest (96% in '06-'07 and '05-'06; 97% in '04-'05; 96% in '03-'04; 96% in '02-'03), 96% of 4,770 eventually passing the mathematics subtest (96% in '06-'07 and '05-'06; 95% in '04-'05; 95% in '03-'04; and 95% in '02-'03), and 92% of 4,746 eventually passing the writing subtest (93% in '06-'07; 92% in '05-'06 and '04-'05; 90% in '03-'04; 91% and in '02-'03).

These cumulative pass rates results were also calculated for ethnic subgroups of examinees. Of the 43 American Indian/Alaskan Natives, 77% met the requirement (69% in '06-'07; 80% in '05-'06; 66% in '04-'05; 75% in '03-'04; and 80% in '02-'03). Of the 239 who identified themselves as Asian/Pacific Islander, 74% met the requirement (75% in '06-'07; 74% in '05-'06; 69% in '04-'05; 71% in '03-'04; and 73% in '02-'03). Of the 79 Black/African Americans, 58% met the requirement (60% in '06-'07; 63% in '05-'06; 58% in '04-'05; 62% in '03-'04; 68% in '02-'03). Of the 199 Hispanic examinees, 63% met the requirement (65% in '06-'07; 58% in '05-'06; 64% in '04-'05; 67% in '03-'04; and 70% in '02-'03). Of the 146 examinees multi-racial examinees, 88% met the requirement (89% in '06-'07; 84% in '05-'06; 83% in '04-'05; 89% in '03-'04; and 87% in '02-'03). Of the 3,714 examinees who identified themselves as White, 89% met the WEST-B requirement (89% in '06-'07, '05-'06 and '04-'05; 90% in '03-'04; and 90% in '02-'03). Of the 440 examinees who gave no response about their ethnicity, 90% met the requirement (88% in '06-'07; 89% in '05-'06; 92% in '04-'05; 92% in '03-'04; and 90% in '02-'03).

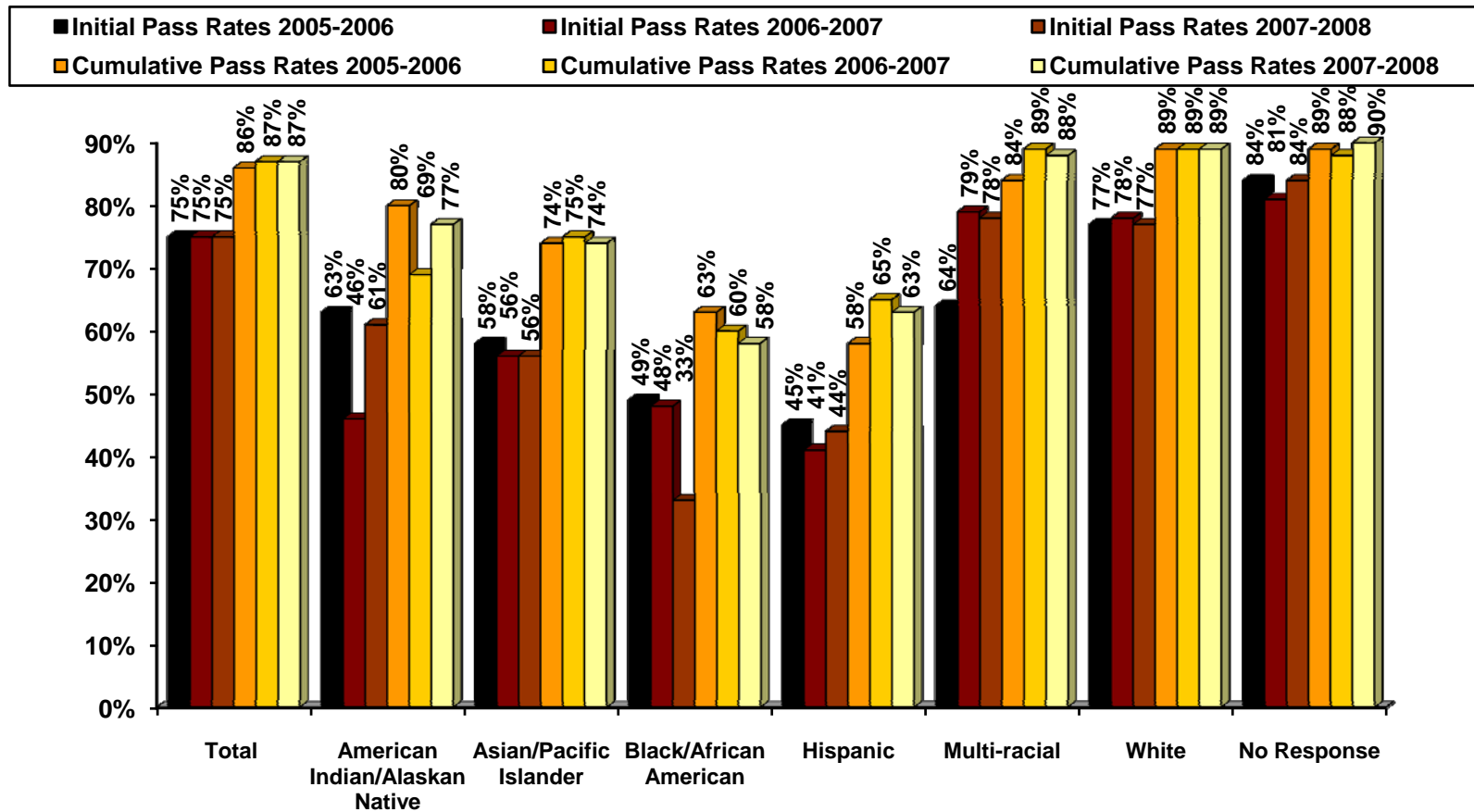

## **Comparison of WEST-B Initial versus Cumulative Pass Rates of All Examinees by Subtests**

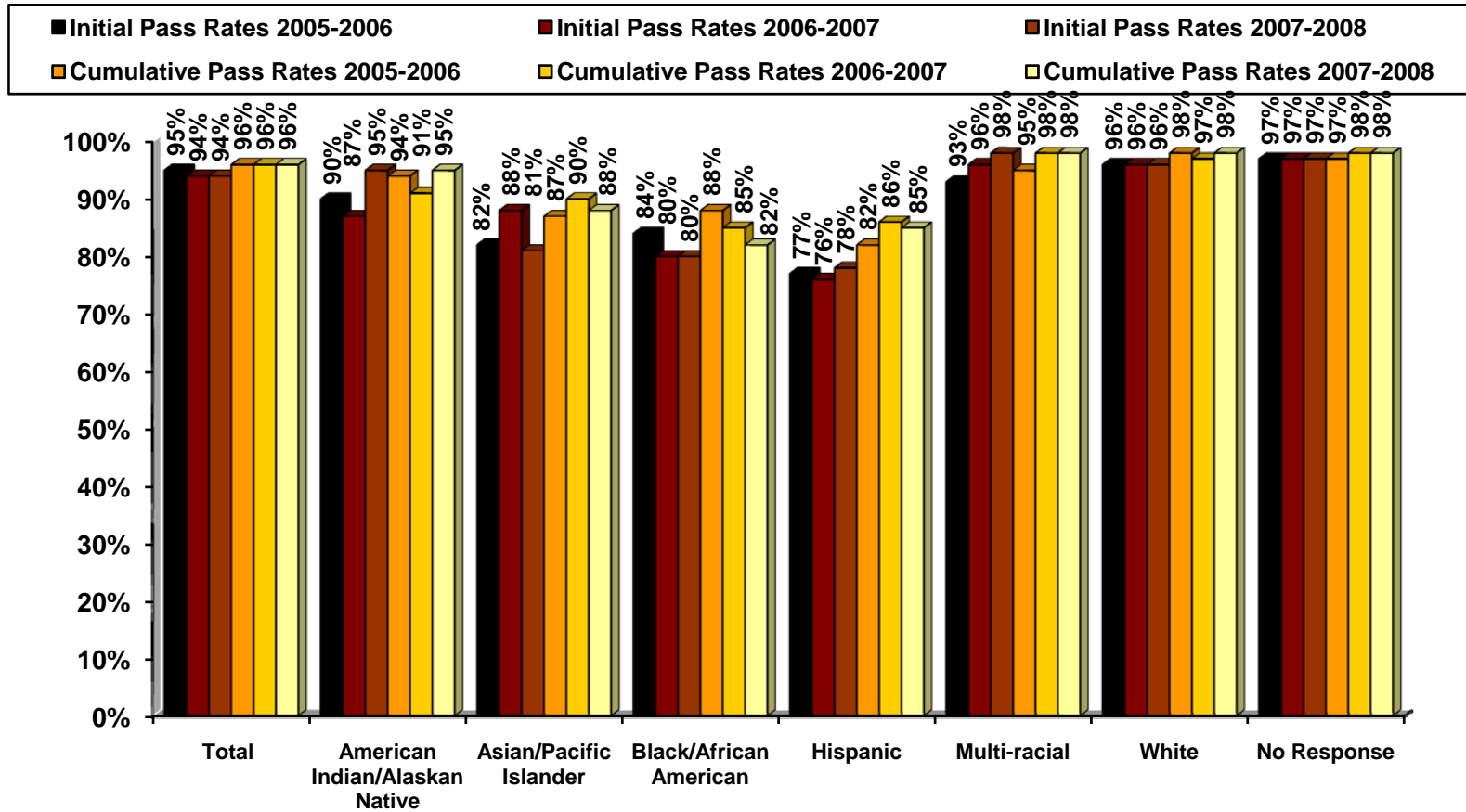

WEST-B SUBTESTS BY ETHNICITY**

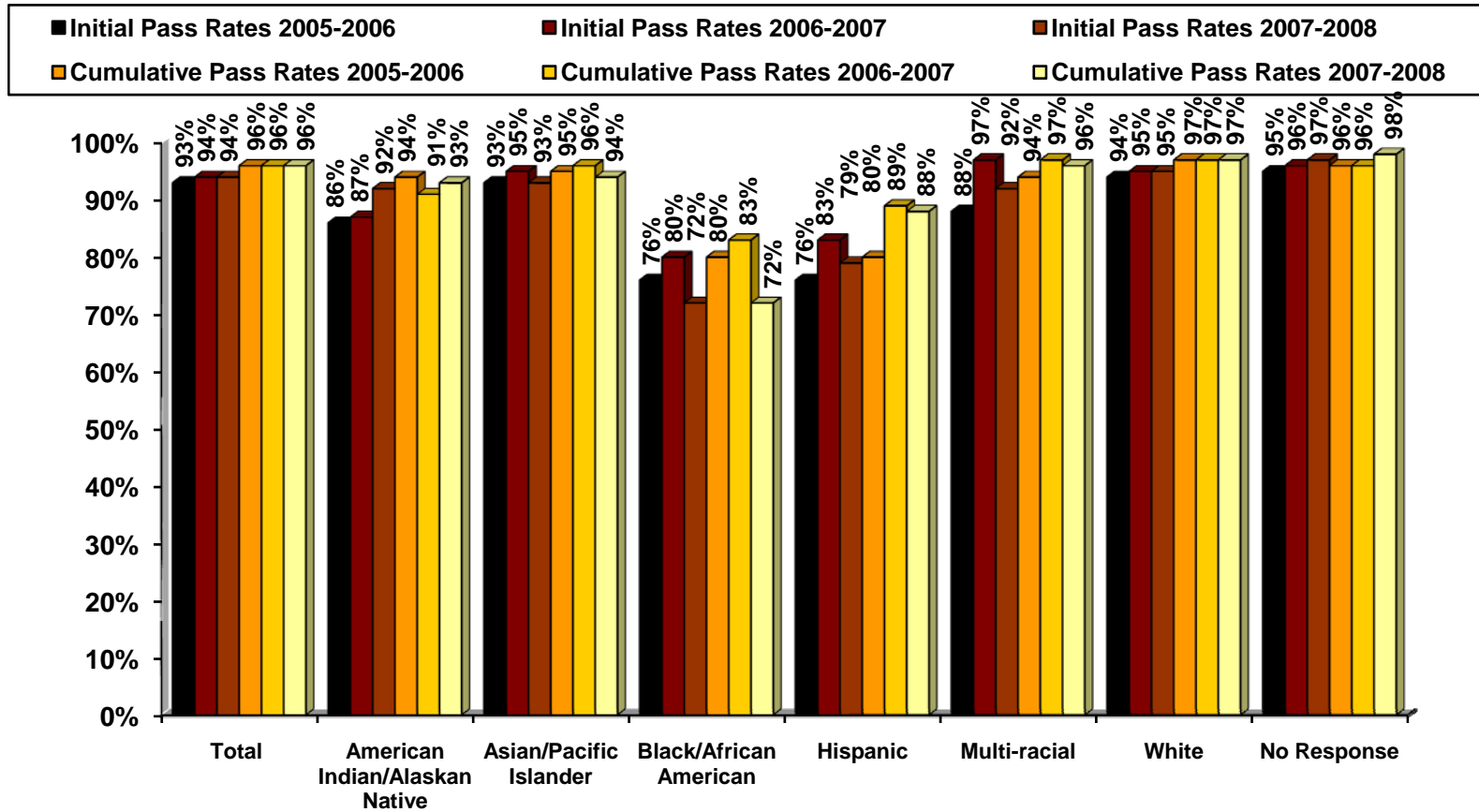




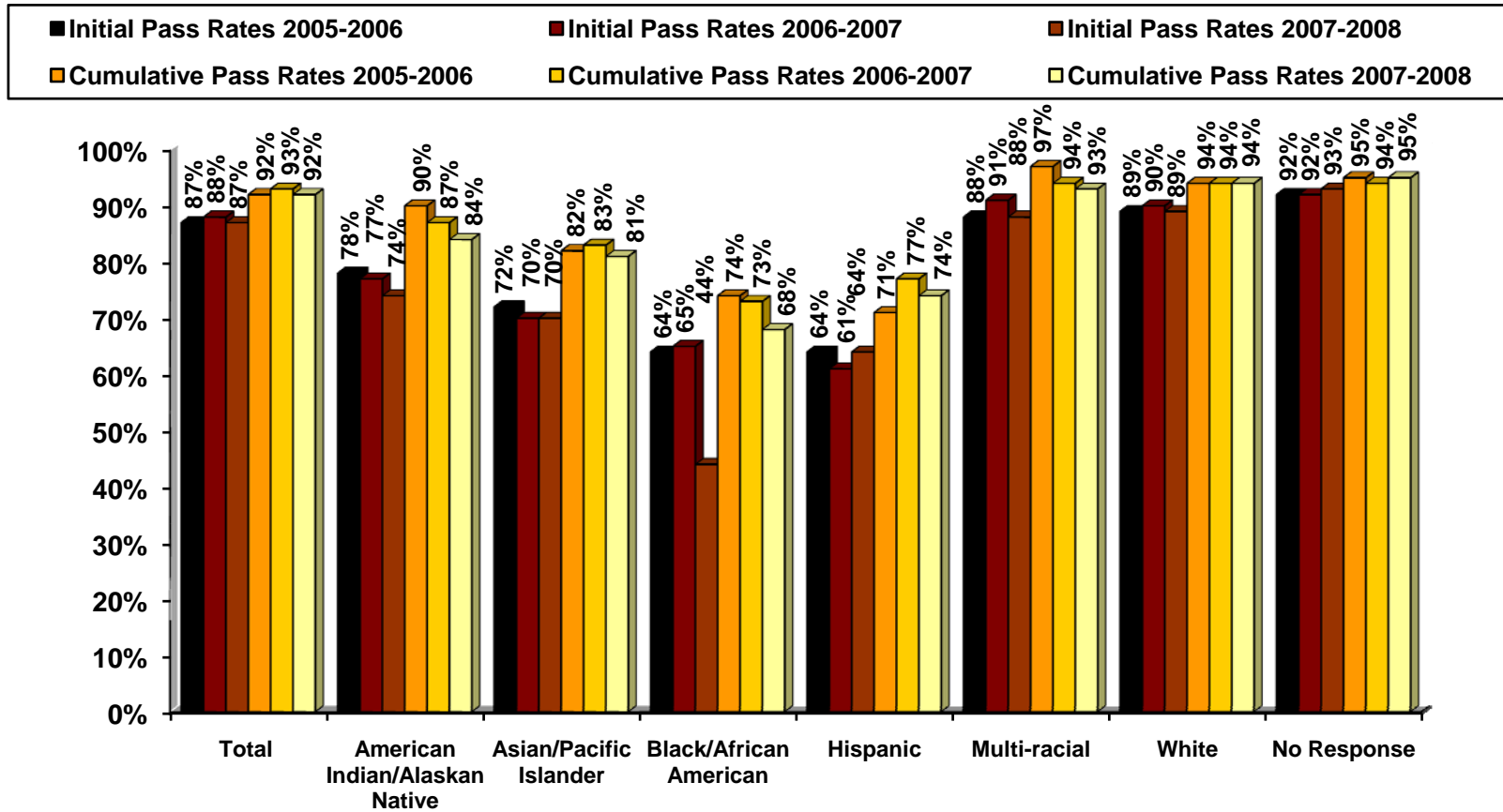

### Six-Year Subtests Cumulative Retake Pass Rates by Ethnicity

Tables 3-5 display the number of attempts made by the gender and ethnic groups to achieve the cumulative passing rates for each of the WEST-B subtests of reading, mathematics and writing.

### Reading Sixth-Year Cumulative Retake Pass Rates by Ethnicity

Of the 34,729 examinees who took the reading subtest between August 2002 and August 2008, 94% passed on the initial attempt, and 98% passed by the third attempt. Of the 305 examinees who identified themselves as American Indian/Alaskan Native, 93% passed on the initial attempt, and 97% passed by the second attempt. Of the 1,470 examinees who identified themselves as Asian American/Pacific Islander, 83% passed on the initial attempt, and 92% passed by the fifth attempt. Of the 525 examinees who identified themselves as Black/African American, 81% passed on the initial attempt, and 90% passed by the third attempt. Of the 1,387 examinees who identified themselves as Hispanic, 79% passed on the initial attempt, and 92% passed by the fifth attempt. Of the 997 examinees who identified themselves as Multi-racial, and 94% passed on the initial attempt, and 98% passed on the fourth attempt. Of the 27,166 examinees who identified themselves as White, 95% passed on the initial attempt, and 99% passed by the fourth attempt. Note: Designations for gender and ethnicity are based on examinee responses during registration to questions that are “optional.” Because some examinees did not respond to this question, the sum of examinees in the reporting groups may not equal the number of “Total Examinees.”

### Mathematics Sixth-Year Cumulative Retake Pass Rates by Ethnicity

Of the 34,609 examinees who took the mathematics subtest between August 2002 and August 2008, 93% passed on the initial attempt, and 97% passed by the third attempt. Of the 296 examinees who identified themselves as American Indian/Alaskan Native, 87% passed on the initial attempt, and 96% passed by the fifth attempt. Of the 1,467 examinees who identified themselves as Asian American/Pacific Islander, 91% passed on the initial attempt, and 95% passed by the third attempt. Of the 527 examinees who identified themselves as Black/African American, 70% passed on the initial attempt, and 85% passed by the fifth attempt. Of the 1,376 examinees who identified themselves as Hispanic, 79% passed on the initial attempt, and 91% passed by the fifth attempt. Of the 990 examinees who identified themselves as Multi-racial, and 91% passed on the initial attempt, and 97% passed on the fourth attempt. Of the 27,086 examinees who identified themselves as White, 94% passed on the initial attempt, and 98% passed by the third attempt. Note: Designations for gender and ethnicity are based on examinee responses to a question on the registration form that is “optional.” Because some examinees did not respond to this question, the sum of examinees in the reporting groups may not equal the number of “Total Examinees.”

### Writing Sixth-Year Cumulative Retake Pass Rates by Ethnicity

Of the 34,570 examinees who took the writing subtest between August 2002 and August 2008, 86% passed on the initial attempt, and 95% passed by the third attempt. Of the 301 examinees who identified themselves as American Indian/Alaskan Native, 76% passed on the initial attempt, and 91% passed by the fifth attempt. Of the 1,455 examinees who identified themselves as Asian American/Pacific Islander, 67% passed on the initial attempt, and 85% passed by the fifth attempt. Of the 522 examinees who identified themselves as Black/African American, 56% passed on the initial attempt, and 81% passed by the fifth attempt. Of the 1,355 examinees who identified themselves as Hispanic, 60% passed on the initial attempt, and 84% passed by the fifth attempt. Of the 989 examinees who identified themselves as Multi-racial, 85% passed on the initial attempt, and 95% passed by the fourth attempt. Of the 27,081 examinees who identified themselves as White, 88% passed on the initial attempt, and 97% passed by the fifth attempt. Note: Designations for gender and ethnicity are based on examinee responses to a question on the registration form that is “optional.” Because some examinees did not respond to this question, the sum of examinees in the reporting groups may not equal the number of “Total Examinees.”

**2006-07 Examinees Who Did Not Attempt All Subtests by the End of the 2007-08 Test Year**

Table 6 displays the 4,674 examinees who attempted at least one subtest across all administrations during the previous 2006-07 test year. (1,111 were out-of-state applicants who indicated that they attend or attended a college or university outside Washington State on their registration form in response to a background question regarding the undergraduate college or university attended.) Of the 4,674 examinees tested in 2006-07, 4,348 (93%) passed all three subtests.

## Statewide Results of Candidates Admitted to Teacher Preparation Programs

State statute specifies that the PESB implement the WEST-B as a requirement for admissions to state approved teacher preparation programs. Prior to the WEST-B, individual programs used other means and measures to ensure that candidates had basic skills. With the implementation of the WEST-B, all state approved programs now use a single, uniform measure of basic skills achievement.

Beginning in 2003, through cooperation with NES and the teacher preparation institutions, the *Data Collection and Reporting System for Admitted Candidates* was implemented. For this purpose, admitted candidates are defined as persons who have been admitted to a state-approved teacher preparation program during the academic year. The academic year is defined as September 1 through August 31. Admitted candidates include all those who are documented as "fully" admitted, having met all state and institutional requirements, and "conditionally" admitted, having been granted additional time to meet all state and institutional requirements.

The collected data (Table 4) from the *Data Collection and Reporting System for Admitted Candidates* show that 3,079 candidates were admitted by the 21 institutions and five alternative routes to certification with PESB-approved teacher preparation programs in 2007-08. Of 3,079 admitted candidates, 2,967 (96%) attempted all three subtests of the WEST-B at least once; of whom 2,895 (98%) completed the WEST-B requirement, and 184 (6%) had not completed the WEST-B requirement before August 31, 2007, the end of the 2007-08 test year. The percentages of admitted candidates who had not completed the WEST-B requirement by the end of the 2007-08 test year ranged from 0% to 22% among the teacher preparation institutions (0% to 23% in '06-'07 and '05-'06; 0% to 26% in '04-'05; 0%-33% in '03-'04). The statewide average is 6% (8% in '06-'07; 7% in '05-'06 and '04-'05; 5% in '03-'04).

## Statewide Range of Subtest Scores for Admitted Candidates by Gender and Ethnicity

Tables 8-10 display by gender and ethnicity, the statewide range of scores for each of the subtests of reading, mathematics and writing. Table 8 displays the results of the reading subtest. Of the 3,079 admitted candidates who attempted the reading subtest, 2,961 (99%) passed (98% passed in '06-'07; 99% passed in '05-'06, '04-'05 and '03-'04 test years). The mean score of passing candidates was 271 (270 in '06-'07; 272 in '05-'06 and in '04-'05; 273 in '03-'04) within a passing range of 240 to 300. (The same in '06-'07; '05-'06, '04-'05 and '03-'04).

Table 9 displays the results of the mathematics subtest. Of the 3,079 admitted candidates who attempted the mathematics subtest, 2,945 (99%) passed (98% passed in the '06-'07 and '05-'06 test years; 99% in the '04-'05 test year; 98% in '03-'04.) The mean score was 278 within a passing range of 240 to 300. (The mean was 277 in '06-'07; 276 in '05-'06, '04-'05 and 276 '03-'04).

Table 10 displays the results of the writing subtest. Of the 3,079 admitted candidates who attempted the writing subtest, 2,926 (98%) passed (96% passed in '06-'07; 98% in '05-'06 and '04-'05 test year; 97% passed in '03-'04). The mean score of passing candidates was 265 within a passing range of 240 to 300. (The mean score was 265 in '06-'07; 264 in '05-'06, '04-'05 and 265 in '03-'04).

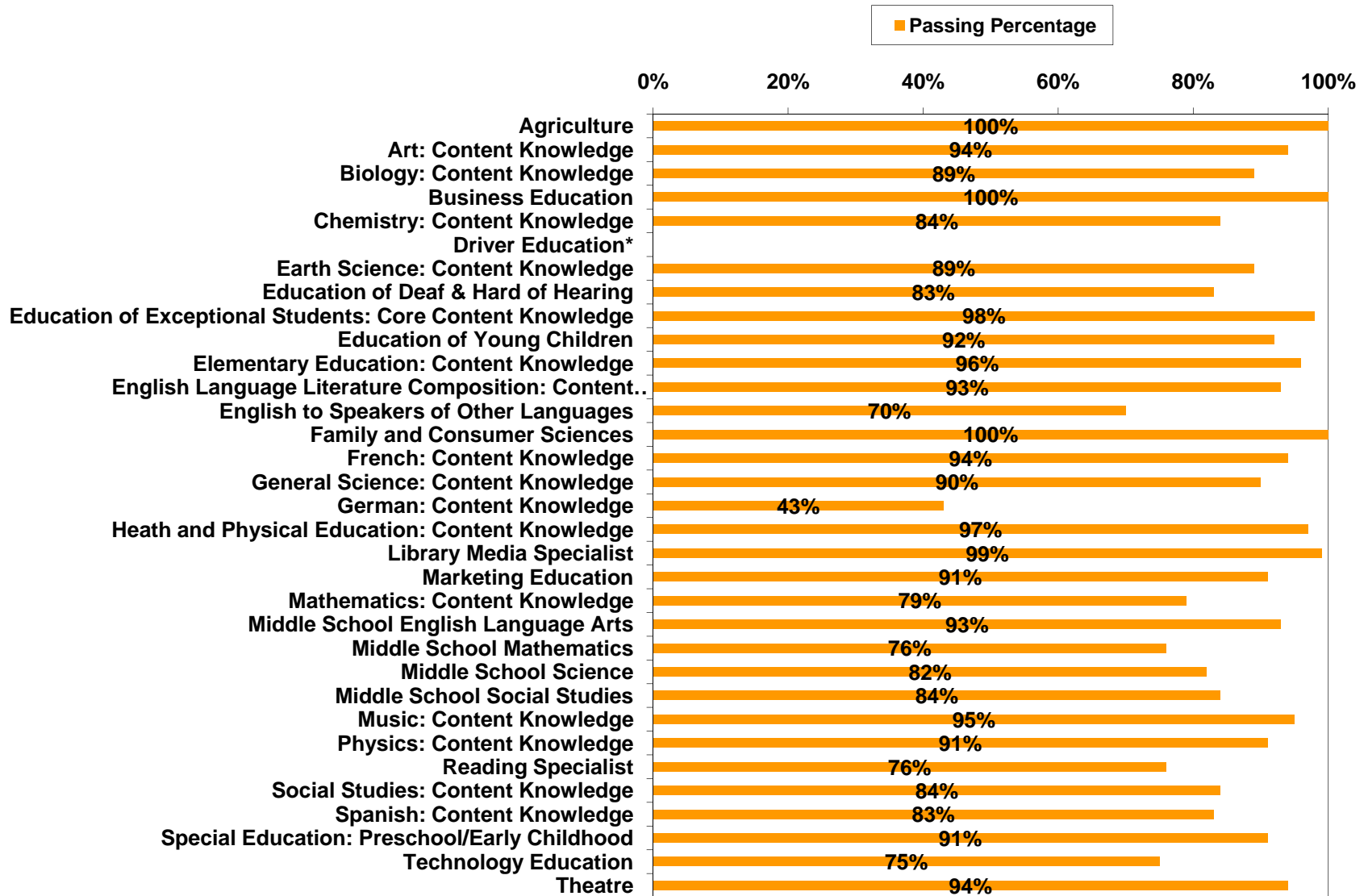

## **Washington Educator Skills Tests – Endorsements (WEST-E)**

RCW 28A.410.220 directs the PESB to implement content knowledge tests to be required of candidates applying for endorsements on the residency certificate. The test requirement was implemented on September 1, 2005. Test administration of the Praxis II tests, selected by the PESB for the use in Washington, took place at ten testing centers across the state on seven dates during the 2007-2008 test year. The state-wide number tested by the individual Praxis II exams range from 2 to 2,646 examinees. The pass rates range from 43% to 100% (72%-100% in '06-'07 and '05-'06) for the individual Praxis II tests.

Table 14 displays a draft of the pass rate percentages of the individual Praxis II series tests used to meet the requirements of the WEST-E, followed by Table 15 that displays the individual test pass rates of all statewide examinees by gender and ethnicity.

### **WEST-E/Praxis II Pass Rates of All Examinees by Gender and Ethnicity**

The state-wide number tested by the individual Praxis II exams range from 2 to 2,646 examinees. The pass rates range from 43% to 100%. Table 15 displays the state-wide WEST-E/Praxis II test results for the total number tested, the mean passing score, the number passed and the passing rate percentage for the gender groups and the ethnic groups of African American, Asian-American, Hispanic, Native American, Pacific Islander, and White as identified by the examinees. Note: Designations for gender and ethnicity are examinee responses to a question on the registration form that is “optional.” Because some examinees did not respond to this question, the sum of examinees in the reporting groups may not equal the number of “Total Number Tested.”

## **Range of WEST-E/Praxis II Passing Scores and Percentages by Institutions with a Teacher Preparation Program**

The pass rates of the examinees who designated an individual institution with a teacher preparation program to receive their scores range from 43% to 100%. Tables 15-44 display the teacher preparation institutions' WEST-E/Praxis II test results for the total number tested, the mean passing score, the number passed and the passing rate percentage for the gender groups and the ethnic groups of African American, Asian-American, Hispanic, Native American, Pacific Islander, and White as identified by the examinees. Note: Designations for gender and ethnicity are examinee responses to a question on the registration form that is "optional." Because some examinees did not respond to this question, the sum of examinees in the reporting groups may not equal the number of "Total Number Tested."

Tables 15-44 display the pass rates by gender and ethnicity for the institutions with a teacher preparation program.
