SUBJECT: MEDICAL AND PUBLIC ASSISTANCE ELIGIBILITY STUDY – INITIAL FINDINGS REPORT

Pursuant to the 2013-15 operating budget (Section 130(3), Chapter 4, Laws of 2013, 2nd Special Session), I am transmitting the report on the Medical and Public Assistance Eligibility Study. The report was compiled for the Office of Financial Management (OFM) by Public Consulting Group (PCG).
