Dear Senator Cleveland and Representative Cody:
This report fulfills the requirements of RCW 18.225 .800 , which directs the Department of Health (department) to annually report, through 2020, the number of times mental health providers ${ }^{1}$ with an associate's license renew their credential four, five, and six times. We submitted our first report in October 2014.

## Major Findings

In state fiscal year 2020, 86.7 percent of those who obtained their mental health provider licensure did so with four or fewer renewals of their associate license. Another 8.1 percent did so with 5 renewals and 5.0 percent with 6 renewals ${ }^{2}$.

## Background

The department began issuing associate licenses for mental health professions in July 2009. At that time, an associate license was limited to no more than four times. This meant associates had five years (initial associate licensure plus four annual renewals) to complete the additional education and supervisory requirements to apply for licensure as a mental health counselor, marriage and family therapist, advanced social worker, or independent clinical social worker.

In 2013, the House Bill 1213 expanded the number of renewals allowed for an associate license from four to six. The bill also directed the department to submit an annual report to help the legislature assess whether these expanded limits on associate licensure renewals remain adequate.
