8 to read as follows:

9 (1) After January 1, 1994, all disability insurance policies that
10 provide coverage for hospital or medical expenses must use for all
11 billing purposes in either paper or electronic format either the health
12 care financing administration (HCFA) 1500 form, or its successor, or
13 the uniform billing (UB) 82 form, or its successor. For billing
14 purposes, this subsection does not apply to pharmacists, dentists, home
15 health/nursing services, eyeglasses, transportation, or vocational
16 services.

17 (2) As of January 1, 1994, the forms developed under section 10 of
18 this act shall be used by providers of health care and carriers under
19 this chapter."

20 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 48.21 RCW
21 to read as follows:

22 (1) After January 1, 1994, all group disability insurance policies
23 that provide coverage for hospital or medical expenses must use for all
24 billing purposes in either paper or electronic format either the health
25 care financing administration (HCFA) 1500 form, or its successor, or
26 the uniform billing (UB) 82 form, or its successor. For billing
27 purposes, this subsection does not apply to pharmacists, dentists, home

1 health/nursing services, eyeglasses, transportation, or vocational
2 services.

3 (2) As of January 1, 1994, the forms developed under section 10 of
4 this act shall be used by providers of health care and carriers under
5 this chapter."

6 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 48.44 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 (1) After January 1, 1994, all health care insurance contracts that
9 provide coverage for hospital or medical expenses must use for all
10 billing purposes in either paper or electronic format either the health
11 care financing administration (HCFA) 1500 form, or its successor, or
12 the uniform billing (UB) 82 form, or its successor. For billing
13 purposes, this subsection does not apply to pharmacists, dentists, home
14 health/nursing services, eyeglasses, transportation, or vocational
15 services.

16 (2) As of January 1, 1994, the forms developed under section 10 of
17 this act shall be used by providers of health care and carriers under
18 this chapter."

19 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 48.46 RCW
20 to read as follows:

21 (1) After January 1, 1994, all health maintenance agreements that
22 provide coverage for hospital or medical expenses must use for all
23 billing purposes in either paper or electronic format either the health
24 care financing administration (HCFA) 1500 form, or its successor, or
25 the uniform billing (UB) 82 form, or its successor. For billing
26 purposes, this subsection does not apply to pharmacists, dentists, home
27 health/nursing services, eyeglasses, transportation, or vocational
28 services.

1 (2) As of January 1, 1994, the forms developed under section 10 of
2 this act shall be used by providers of health care and carriers under
3 this chapter."

4 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 48.84 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) After January 1, 1994, all providers of long-term care that
7 provide coverage for hospital or medical expenses must use for all
8 billing purposes in either paper or electronic format either the health
9 care financing administration (HCFA) 1500 form, or its successor, or
10 the uniform bill (UB) 82 form, or its successor. For billing purposes,
11 this subsection does not apply to pharmacists, dentists, home
12 health/nursing services, eyeglasses, transportation, or vocational
13 services.

14 (2) As of January 1, 1994, the forms developed under section 10 of
15 this act shall be used by providers of health care and carriers under
16 this chapter."

17 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 41.05 RCW
18 to read as follows:

19 After July 1, 1994, the health care financing administration (HCFA)
20 1500 form, or its successor, and the uniform billing (UB) 82 form, or
21 its successor, shall be used in either paper or electronic format for
22 state-paid health care services provided through the health care
23 authority. The forms developed under section 10 of this act shall be
24 used for billing purposes for pharmacists, dentists, home
25 health/nursing services, eyeglasses, transportation, or vocational
26 services."

1 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 7.** A new section is added to chapter 43.20A
2 RCW to read as follows:

3 After July 1, 1994, the health care financing administration (HCFA)
4 1500 form, or its successor, and the uniform billing (UB) 82 form, or
5 its successor, shall be used in either paper or electronic format for
6 state-paid health care services provided by the department. The forms
7 developed under section 10 of this act shall be used for billing
8 purposes for pharmacists, dentists, home health/nursing services,
9 eyeglasses, transportation, or vocational services."

10 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 8.** A new section is added to Title 51 RCW to
11 read as follows:

12 After July 1, 1994, the health care financing administration (HCFA)
13 1500 form, or its successor, and the uniform billing (UB) 82 form, or
14 its successor, shall be used in either paper or electronic format for
15 state-paid health care services provided under this title. The forms
16 developed under section 10 of this act shall be used for billing
17 purposes for pharmacists, dentists, home health/nursing services,
18 eyeglasses, transportation, or vocational services."

19 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 9.** A new section is added to chapter 70.47 RCW
20 to read as follows:

21 After July 1, 1994, the health care financing administration (HCFA)
22 1500 form, or its successor, and the uniform billing (UB) 82 form, or
23 its successor, shall be used in either paper or electronic format for
24 state-paid health care services provided under the basic health plan.
25 The forms developed under section 10 of this act shall be used for
26 billing purposes for pharmacists, dentists, home health/nursing
27 services, eyeglasses, transportation, or vocational services."
