2 amending RCW 43.03.011, 43.03.012, and 43.03.013.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.03.011 and 1991 sp.s. c 1 s 1 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 Pursuant to Article XXVIII, section 1 of the state Constitution and RCW
