1 AN ACT Relating to the sale of informational materials by the
2 department of fisheries; adding a new section to chapter 75.08 RCW; and
3 creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** It is the intent of the legislature to
6 promote the distribution of public information concerning the food fish
7 and shellfish resources in this state, and to recover the costs of
8 drafting and publishing of informational materials to the extent
9 reasonably possible through the sale of such materials, except for
10 regulation pamphlets, which should continue to be distributed at no
11 charge.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 75.08 RCW
13 to read as follows:

1 The director may collect moneys to recover the reasonable costs of
2 drafting and publishing informational materials, except regulation
3 pamphlets, relating to food fish and shellfish under the jurisdiction
4 of the department. "Reasonable costs" shall include costs of drafting,
5 printing, distribution, and postage.

6 Moneys collected by the director under this section shall be
7 deposited in the state general fund.
