1            WHEREAS, Association with the Washington State Legislature, as a  
2 Representative or a Senator, in a staff position, as a lobbyist, or  
3 through a news media assignment, forges a strong bond of personal  
4 relationship among those who have shared this experience; and

5            WHEREAS, These long-standing legislative relationships have been  
6 maintained through a biennial gathering, originated informally, known  
7 as the "Old Timers" Reunion; and

8            WHEREAS, Perpetuating this common interest, and preserving the  
9 traditions of public and professional service on which it is based,  
10 strengthens the legislative process and contributes to the  
11 institutional integrity of the legislature;

12            NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives,  
13 the Senate concurring, That there shall be a "Legislative Old Timers"  
14 Reunion and related events planned and conducted as a formal and  
15 official program of this legislative session; and

1           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That each caucus of the House of  
2 Representatives and the Senate designate a member to form a committee  
3 which shall be responsible for facilitating such a purpose with the  
4 enlisted assistance of other active and former legislators, staff  
5 members, lobbyists and news people so that the Legislative Old Timers  
6 program will provide a permanent connection of the past with the  
7 present for the betterment of the State of Washington.
