

VETO MESSAGE ON HB 2359-S

March 31, 1992

To the Honorable, the House
of Representatives of the
State of Washington

Ladies and Gentlemen:

I am returning herewith, without my approval as to section 5,
Substitute House Bill No. 2359 entitled:

"AN ACT Relating to academic, vocational, and technological
education."

Substitute House Bill No. 2359 establishes pilot projects to
integrate vocational and academic education in secondary schools.
Section 5 would set certain requirements for the pilot project
applications submitted to the Superintendent of Public Instruction.
Section 5 references requests for waivers even though the original
language specifying such waivers does not appear in the substitute
bill. A veto of this section is necessary to eliminate confusion
with waivers.

For this reason, I have vetoed section 5 of Substitute House
Bill No. 2359.

With the exception of section 5, Substitute House Bill No.
2359 is approved.
