1 AN ACT Relating to exempting juvenile newspaper carriers from
2 business and occupation tax; adding a new section to chapter 82.04 RCW;
3 adding a new section to chapter 35.21 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 This chapter shall not apply to a newspaper carrier under eighteen
8 years of age.

9 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 35.21 RCW
10 to read as follows:

11 A city or town, including a code city, may not license newspaper
12 carriers under eighteen years of age for either regulatory or revenue-
13 generating purposes.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** Each person employing or contracting with a
15 juvenile newspaper carrier for delivery of newspapers shall notify the

1 carrier in writing that the exemption provided in section 1 of this act
2 expires when the carrier reaches eighteen years of age.
