1 AN ACT Relating to studded tires; and amending RCW 47.36.250 and
2 46.37.420.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.36.250 and 1987 c 330 s 747 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 If the department or its delegate determines at any time for any
7 part of the public highway system that the unsafe conditions of the
8 roadway require particular tires, tire chains, or traction equipment in
9 addition to or beyond the ordinary pneumatic rubber tires, the
10 department may establish the following recommendations or requirements
11 with respect to the use of such equipment for all persons using such
12 public highway:

13 (1) Dangerous road conditions, chains or other approved traction
14 devices recommended.

15 (2) Dangerous road conditions, chains or other approved traction
16 devices required.

17 (3) Dangerous road conditions, chains required.

18 Any equipment that may be required by this section shall be
19 approved by the state patrol as authorized under RCW 46.37.420.

1 The department shall place and maintain signs and other traffic
2 control devices on the public highways that indicate the tire, tire
3 chain, or traction equipment recommendation or requirement determined
4 under this section. (~~Such signs or traffic control devices shall in
5 no event prohibit the use of studded tires from November 1st to April
6 1st, but when the department determines that chains are required and
7 that no other traction equipment will suffice, the requirement is
8 applicable to all types of tires including studded tires.~~) The signs
9 or traffic control devices may specify different recommendations or
10 requirements for four-wheel drive vehicles in gear.

11 Failure to obey a requirement indicated by a sign or other traffic
12 control device placed or maintained under this section is a
13 misdemeanor.

14 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.37.420 and 1990 c 105 s 1 are each amended to read
15 as follows:

16 (1) It is unlawful to operate a vehicle upon the public highways of
17 this state unless it is completely equipped with pneumatic rubber tires
18 except vehicles equipped with temporary-use spare tires that meet
19 federal standards that are installed and used in accordance with the
20 manufacturer's instructions.

21 (2) No tire on a vehicle moved on a highway may have on its
22 periphery any block, flange, cleat, or spike or any other protuberance
23 of any material other than rubber which projects beyond the tread of
24 the traction surface of the tire, except that it is permissible (a) to
25 use farm machinery with tires having protuberances that will not injure
26 the highway, and (~~except also that it is permissible~~) (b) to use tire
27 chains (~~or metal studs imbedded within the tire of reasonable
28 proportions and of a type conforming to rules adopted by the state
29 patrol, upon any vehicle when required for safety because of snow, ice,
30 or other conditions tending to cause a vehicle to skid. It is unlawful
31 to use metal studs imbedded within the tire between April 1st and
32 November 1st. The state department of transportation may, from time to
33 time, determine additional periods in which the use of tires with metal
34 studs imbedded therein is lawful~~)).

35 (3) The state department of transportation and local authorities in
36 their respective jurisdictions may issue special permits authorizing
37 the operation upon a highway of traction engines or tractors having
38 movable tracks with transverse corrugations upon the periphery of the

1 movable tracks or farm tractors or other farm machinery, the operation
2 of which upon a highway would otherwise be prohibited under this
3 section.

4 ~~((4) Tires with metal studs imbedded therein may be used between
5 November 1st and April 1st upon school buses and fire department
6 vehicles, any law or regulation to the contrary notwithstanding.))~~
