1 AN ACT Relating to alcoholic beverage control; and amending RCW
2 66.08.180.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 66.08.180 and 1987 c 458 s 10 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Moneys in the liquor revolving fund shall be distributed by the
7 board at least once every three months in accordance with RCW
8 66.08.190, 66.08.200 and 66.08.210(~~(:—PROVIDED, That)~~). The board
9 shall reserve from distribution such amount not exceeding five hundred
10 thousand dollars as may be necessary for the proper administration of
11 this title(~~(:—AND PROVIDED FURTHER, That)~~). All license fees,
12 penalties and forfeitures derived under this act from class H licenses
13 or class H licensees shall every three months be disbursed by the board
14 as follows:

15 (1) 5.95 percent to the University of Washington and 3.97 percent
16 to Washington State University for alcoholism and drug abuse research
17 and for the dissemination of such research;

18 (2) 1.75 percent, but in no event less than ((one)) three hundred
19 ((fifty)) thousand dollars per biennium, to the University of

1 Washington to conduct the state toxicological laboratory pursuant to
2 RCW ((~~68.08.107~~)) 68.50.107;

3 (3) 88.33 percent to the general fund to be used by the department
4 of social and health services solely to carry out the purposes of ((RCW
5 ~~70.96.085, as now or hereafter amended~~)) chapter 70.96A RCW;

6 (4) The first fifty-five dollars per license fee provided in RCW
7 66.24.320 and 66.24.330 up to a maximum of one hundred fifty thousand
8 dollars annually shall be disbursed every three months by the board to
9 the general fund to be used for juvenile alcohol and drug prevention
10 programs for kindergarten through third grade to be administered by the
11 superintendent of public instruction;

12 (5) Twenty percent of the remaining total amount derived from
13 license fees pursuant to RCW 66.24.320, 66.24.330, 66.24.340,
14 66.24.350, 66.24.360, and 66.24.370, shall be transferred to the
15 general fund to be used by the department of social and health services
16 solely to carry out the purposes of ((~~RCW 70.96.085~~)) chapter 70.96A
17 RCW; and

18 (6) One-fourth cent per liter of the tax imposed by RCW 66.24.210
19 shall every three months be disbursed by the board to Washington State
20 University solely for wine and wine grape research, extension programs
21 related to wine and wine grape research, and resident instruction in
22 both wine grape production and the processing aspects of the wine
23 industry in accordance with RCW 28B.30.068. The director of financial
24 management shall prescribe suitable accounting procedures to ensure
25 that the funds transferred to the general fund to be used by the
26 department of social and health services and appropriated are
27 separately accounted for.
