
SENATE BILL 6498

State of Washington 53rd Legislature 1994 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to community and technical college capital
2 projects; adding new sections to chapter 28B.50 RCW; and creating new
3 sections.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature recognizes that quality in
6 the state's community and technical colleges would be strengthened by
7 additional partnerships between citizens, private industry, and the
8 colleges. The intent of this act is to encourage community and
9 technical colleges to raise money from private sources for capital
10 projects by providing state funds to match the private money or
11 contribution for a specific capital project.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.50 RCW
13 to read as follows:

14 The community and technical college capital account is hereby
15 created in the general fund. The college board shall adopt rules and
16 procedures that shall govern the recommendations for use of funds
17 appropriated to the community and technical college capital account.

1 The college board shall include in the biennial capital budget
2 request for the community and technical college system any project
3 proposed for funding from the community and technical college capital
4 account, including the amounts of funding to be available from private
5 sources, from the community and technical college capital account, and
6 from the general capital appropriation to the community and technical
7 college system.

8 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.50 RCW
9 to read as follows:

10 The college board shall include in its biennial capital budget
11 request a description of expenditures made pursuant to prior
12 legislative appropriations of community and technical college capital
13 account funds.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** By January 15, 1995, the college board shall
15 submit to the legislature a report setting forth its plans for
16 implementing the provisions of chapter . . . , Laws of 1994 (this act).
17 The report shall include the college board's policy and criteria for
18 recommending allocations of available funds in the community and
19 technical college capital account and the procedures to be followed by
20 applicants.
