1 AN ACT Relating to major noninterstate highway construction; making
2 an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The sum of fifty million dollars, or as much
5 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund to
6 the department of transportation for the biennium ending June 30, 1995.
7 This appropriation shall be expended exclusively for major
8 noninterstate highway construction projects formerly identified by the
9 department of transportation as category "C" projects and currently
10 identified as improvement projects under RCW 47.05.030.

11 It is the intent of the legislature that this appropriation shall
12 be funded by savings achieved in state general fund expenditures for
13 the 1993-95 fiscal biennium. To achieve the savings necessary to fund
14 this appropriation, the office of financial management shall make
15 across-the-board reductions in state general fund allotments to all
16 state agencies and institutions for furnishings, equipment, travel,
17 goods and services, and other support costs.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
2 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
3 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
4 effect immediately.
