
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 8426

1 BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the state of Washington, the House
2 of Representatives concurring, That the Joint Legislative Systems
3 Committee shall provide members of the public with electronic access to
4 public legislative information such as the Revised Code of Washington,
5 the Washington Administrative Code, the United States and Washington
6 State Constitutions, bills, bill digests, bill reports, calendars,
7 schedules, and resolutions. In carrying out this responsibility the
8 committee shall consider: The various data bases and documents
9 maintained on the legislative information system; the desire by members
10 of the public for electronic access; the method and format best suited
11 for providing public access; the need to provide the most current and
12 accurate information; the educational purpose that would be served by
13 granting public access; the need to maintain the integrity and security
14 of the legislative computer system; the capital and operating costs of
15 providing public access; and the desirability of providing access at no
16 cost to the general public. By October 1, 1994, the Joint Legislative
17 Systems Committee shall have adopted a plan for carrying out this
18 resolution.
