3 On page 5, beginning on line 16 of the striking amendment,
4 strike everything through "(6)" on page 6, line 11 of the striking
5 amendment, and insert the following:

6 "(2) Any parent concerned about a specific subject area shall,
7 by written notice, so inform the school principal or school
8 district superintendent about the specific concern. Such written
9 notification shall be received before the beginning of any school
10 year or term whenever possible. During a school term, any parent
11 concerned about a specific subject area may, by written request to
12 the principal or district superintendent, be given notice no less
13 than five days before a school's or school district's presentation
14 or instruction in the specific subject area of concern.

15 (3) Parents have the right to exempt their child from
16 participation in any subject area concerning human sexuality and
17 must follow the following procedures:

18 (a) An exemption from a specific day of class must be in
19 writing and received by the teacher at least three days before the
20 planned specific instruction; or

21 (b) An exemption from a specific class or course for the
22 entire school year or term, or remainder of the school year or
23 term, must be received in writing by the school principal at least
24 five days before the scheduled start of that class or course.

27 Correct internal references accordingly

EFFECT: Notice and consent provisions of the underlying
amendment are stricken and replaced. If a parent is concerned
about a certain subject, the parent must let the school know

in writing. A parent may exempt a child from a class or course if the parent provides notice in writing within a specified time period in advance of the class or course.
