**Title:** An act relating to penetration bullets.

**Brief Description:** Outlawing possession of cartridges designed to penetrate life-saving devices.

**Background:** There have been recent announcements regarding bullets that are designed to penetrate life-saving devices and cause major internal injuries.

**Summary of Bill:** It is a class C felony to possess a bullet that is designed or manufactured to penetrate a life-saving device. This prohibition does not apply to law enforcement or the military.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Not requested.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
