1 AN ACT Relating to independent contractors or outside agents who
2 sell or arrange for travel services; adding a new section to chapter
3 50.04 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 50.04 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 The term "employment" does not include services by an independent
8 contractor or outside agent who sells or arranges for travel services
9 that are provided to a travel agent as defined in RCW 19.138.021, where
10 the independent contractor or outside agent is paid by commission.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** If any part of this act is found to be in
12 conflict with federal requirements that are a prescribed condition to
13 the allocation of federal funds to the state or the eligibility of
14 employers in this state for federal unemployment tax credits, the
15 conflicting part of this act is hereby declared to be inoperative
16 solely to the extent of the conflict, and such finding or determination
17 shall not affect the operation of the remainder of this act. The rules
18 under this act shall meet federal requirements that are a necessary

1 condition to the receipt of federal funds by the state or the granting
2 of federal unemployment tax credits to employers in this state.
