1 AN ACT Relating to advertising on school buses; and adding a new  
2 section to chapter 46.61 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) The rules of the state superintendent of public instruction  
7 under RCW 46.61.380 governing the marking of school buses shall allow  
8 school districts to place advertising and educational material on and  
9 in school buses if such advertising and education material is approved  
10 by the school district board of directors. The advertising and  
11 educational material shall not be placed on the front or rear of a  
12 school bus.

13 (2) Revenue received by the school district for the school bus  
14 advertising and educational material shall be deposited in the school  
15 district's general fund or transportation vehicle fund.
