1 AN ACT Relating to the minimum hourly wage; amending RCW 49.46.020
2 and 49.46.020; providing effective dates; and providing an expiration
3 date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 49.46.020 and 1993 c 309 s 1 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 (1) Every employer shall pay to each of his or her employees who
8 has reached the age of eighteen years wages at a rate of not less than
9 (~~four~~) five dollars and (~~ninety~~) twenty-five cents per hour.

10 (2) The director shall by regulation establish the minimum wage for
11 employees under the age of eighteen years.

12 **Sec. 2.** RCW 49.46.020 and 1993 c 309 s 1 are each amended to read
13 as follows:

14 (1) Every employer shall pay to each of his or her employees who
15 has reached the age of eighteen years wages at a rate of not less than
16 (~~four~~) five dollars and (~~ninety~~) forty-three cents per hour.

17 (2) The director shall by regulation establish the minimum wage for
18 employees under the age of eighteen years.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** (1) Section 1 of this act shall take effect
2 January 1, 1996;

3 (2) Section 2 of this act shall take effect January 1, 1997.

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** Section 1 of this act shall expire January
5 1, 1997.
