1 AN ACT Relating to higher education tuition; and amending RCW  
2 28B.15.556.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.15.556 and 1993 sp.s. c 18 s 21 are each amended  
5 to read as follows:

6 Subject to the limitations of RCW 28B.15.910, the governing boards  
7 of the state universities, the regional universities, and The Evergreen  
8 State College may waive all or a portion of the tuition, and services  
9 and activities fees for undergraduate or graduate students of foreign  
10 nations subject to the following limitations:

11 ~~(1) ((No more than the equivalent of one hundred waivers may be~~  
12 ~~awarded to undergraduate or graduate students of foreign nations at~~  
13 ~~each of the two state universities;~~

14 ~~(2) No more than the equivalent of twenty waivers may be awarded to~~  
15 ~~undergraduate or graduate students of foreign nations at each of the~~  
16 ~~regional universities and The Evergreen State College;~~

17 ~~(3))~~ Priority in the awarding of waivers shall be given to  
18 students on academic exchanges or academic special programs sponsored  
19 by recognized international educational organizations; and

1        (~~(4)~~) (2) An undergraduate or graduate student of a foreign  
2 nation receiving a waiver under this section is not eligible for any  
3 other waiver.

4        The waiver programs under this section, to the greatest extent  
5 possible, shall promote reciprocal placements and waivers in foreign  
6 nations for Washington residents. The number of waivers awarded by  
7 each institution shall not exceed the number of that institution's own  
8 students enrolled in approved study programs abroad during the same  
9 period.
