1 AN ACT Relating to school district public surveys; and amending RCW  
2 28A.320.090.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.320.090 and 1969 ex.s. c 283 s 11 are each amended  
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) The board of directors of any school district shall have  
7 authority to authorize the expenditure of funds for the purpose of:

8 (a) Preparing and distributing information to the general public to  
9 explain the instructional program, operation and maintenance of the  
10 schools of the district( (:—PROVIDED, That nothing contained herein))i

11 (b) Determining public concerns and opinions regarding the  
12 instructional program and the operation and maintenance of the schools  
13 of the district; and

14 (c) Providing public opinion data to the board to assist its  
15 decisions about holding elections on particular funding measures.

1        (2) This section shall not be construed to authorize preparation  
2 and distribution of information or inquiries to the general public for  
3 the purpose of influencing the outcome of a school district election.
