Brief Description: Granting to adult court jurisdiction over juveniles who use a firearm while committing a violent offense.

HB 1021-S - DIGEST

(SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 2ND SUB)

Grants automatic jurisdiction over juveniles sixteen and seventeen years of age who use a firearm while committing a violent offense to adult courts.

Requires mandatory decline hearings for fourteen and fifteen year old juveniles.
