Brief Description: Establishing parents' rights in common school education.

**HB 1172 - DIGEST**

(SEE ALSO PROPOSED 1ST SUB)

Requires the board of directors of a school district to make available to a parent any educational program and all instructional materials.

Provides that a student may not be placed in an experimental, special, or pilot class without the written consent of a parent.

Limits the use of intelligence quotient proficiency tests.

Declares that a parent has the right to expect that a student will receive a basic education.

Provides parents with the right to redress.
