Brief Description: Authorizing counties to supervise misdemeanor offenders placed on probation.

HB 1357-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/11/95)

Provides that, at the beginning of each biennium, a county legislative authority has the option to elect to assume responsibility for the supervision of defendants convicted of a misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor.

Requires a county electing to assume supervision responsibility to be responsible for all misdemeanor probationers in the county for the duration of the biennium.

Directs the law and justice advisory council to establish standards for the supervision of misdemeanor probationers.

Requires the counties to agree to abide by the standards before funds can be authorized.

Authorizes the department or the county to assess and collect from a defendant for the duration of the term of supervision a monthly sum not to exceed one hundred dollars per month.
