**HB 1929-S - DIGEST**

(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Designates tax reduction industries as those operated to provide work training and employment opportunities for jail inmates and which reduce public support costs.

Designates the approved disposition of the goods and services of the industries.

Clarifies the role and responsibility of the advisory board.

Provides criteria for medical aid benefits and industrial insurance coverage.
