Brief Description: Prohibiting lobbying activities by representatives of taxpayer-supported agencies or units of government.

HB 2289-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 2/7/96)

Provides that representatives of taxpayer-supported agencies or units of government may not participate in lobbying activities.

Allows designated officials to engage in lobbying activities.

Authorizes a civil fine of not more than one thousand dollars for each violation.
