Brief Description: Providing a cause of action for persons who are coerced into sexually explicit conduct.

SB 6131-S - DIGEST

(AS OF SENATE 2ND READING 2/7/96)

Provides that "coerced" means that coercion as defined in RCW 9A.36.070.

Provides that "sexually explicit conduct" has the same meaning as in RCW 9.68A.011.

Authorizes a cause of action against any person who coerces another person into a performance, and specifies the penalties for such coercion.
