EFFECT: Increases the number of peace of peace officers on the criminal justice training commission from two to four.

EFFECT: Removes the language requiring that appointments must be from a list submitted by the Washington state council of police officers. Requires that the peace officer have criminal justice training experience.

EFFECT: The amendment strikes all of Section 2, which allows the commission to impose fees on new recruits for the cost of their mandatory basic law enforcement training.
