1 AN ACT Relating to the election to enter the judicial retirement
2 system; and amending RCW 2.10.100.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.10.100 and 1995 c 305 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Retirement of a member for service shall be made by the retirement
7 board as follows:

8 (1) Any judge who, on August 9, 1971 (~~or within one year~~
9 ~~thereafter~~), shall have completed as a judge the years of actual
10 service required under chapter 2.12 RCW and who shall elect to become
11 a member of this system, shall in all respects be deemed qualified to
12 retire under this retirement system upon the member's written request.
13 However, at the time a judge elects to become a member, he or she shall
14 pay into this retirement system a sum equal to any additional
15 deductions from salary that would have been made had the election been
16 made on August 9, 1972.

17 (2) Any member who has completed fifteen or more years of service
18 may be retired upon the member's written request but shall not be

1 eligible to receive a retirement allowance until the member attains the
2 age of sixty years.

3 (3) Any member who attains the age of seventy-five years shall be
4 retired at the end of the calendar year in which the member attains
5 such age.

6 (4) Any judge who involuntarily leaves service or who is appointed
7 to a position as a federal judge or federal magistrate at any time
8 after having served an aggregate of twelve years shall be eligible to
9 a partial retirement allowance computed according to RCW 2.10.110 and
10 shall receive this allowance upon the attainment of the age of sixty
11 years and fifteen years after the beginning of the member's judicial
12 service.
