1 AN ACT Relating to examination eligibility requirements for
2 Washington state patrol officers; and amending RCW 43.43.350.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.43.350 and 1969 ex.s. c 20 s 2 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 Eligibility for examination ~~((or))~~ for promotion shall be
7 determined as follows:

8 Patrol officers with one year of probationary experience, in
9 addition to three years experience as a regular patrolman before the
10 date of the first examination occurrence, shall be eligible for
11 examination for the rank of sergeant; patrol officers with one year of
12 probationary experience in the rank of sergeant before the date of the
13 first examination occurrence, in addition to two years as a regular
14 sergeant, shall be eligible for examination for the rank of lieutenant.
