1 AN ACT Relating to law enforcement officer training by the criminal
2 justice training commission; adding new sections to chapter 43.101 RCW;
3 and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.101 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 By January 1, 2000, the commission shall raise the basic training
8 requirement for law enforcement officers from four hundred forty hours
9 to a minimum of seven hundred twenty hours.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.101 RCW
11 to read as follows:

12 By January 1, 2000, the commission shall offer in-service training
13 to law enforcement officers through operation of a mobile training
14 facility.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** Funding for the expanded training and for
16 the mobile training facility required by this act shall be provided to

1 the criminal justice training commission from the public safety and
2 education account as provided by RCW 43.08.250.
