9 maximizing public access to these lands which all members of the public
10 have helped to pay for. Automobile parking fees also encourage park
11 visitors to park on neighboring land, causing disruption to citizens
12 that are located near parks"

14 On page 2, at line 19, after "vitality" insert: "; and
15 (f) Ensure that parks are open to all individuals, regardless of
16 means, by not charging any sort of fee for basic parkland access
17 including daytime parking fees, except that the commission may charge
18 a boat moorage fee"
