13 General Fund--State Appropriation (FY 2003) . . . \$ 33,602,000

14 The appropriation in this section is subject to the following
15 conditions and limitations:

16 (1) State flexible education funds for the 2002-03 school year
17 shall be allocated at a maximum rate of \$35.12 per full-time equivalent
18 student in grades K-12. For the purpose of this section, "FTE student"
19 refers to the annual average full-time equivalent enrollment of the
20 school district in grades kindergarten through twelve for the prior
21 school year. The funds shall be distributed to school districts at ten
22 percent per month for the months of September through June.

23 (2) Funds are provided for local education program enhancements to
24 improve student learning as identified by each school district,
25 including the following programs: Alternative education programs;
26 paraprofessional training; mentor/beginning teacher assistance;

1 principal assessment and mentorships; superintendent and principal
2 internships; mathematics helping corps; anti-bullying/harassment
3 training; nonviolence leadership training; nursing support; school
4 safety and school safety training; school safety center; Teen Aware;
5 truancy; Cispus; contracting with educational centers; Pacific Science
6 Center programs; civil liberties education; World War II oral history
7 project; summer skills center programs; and extended day skills center.

8 (3) Funds provided under this section shall not be used for salary
9 increases or additional compensation for existing teaching duties.

10 (4) Funding provided under this section does not fall within the
11 definition of basic education for purposes of Article IX of the state
12 Constitution."

EFFECT: Restores \$1,112,000 in specific funding for the Washington state leadership assistance for science education reform (LASER) regional partnership program.

References to the Laser Science Program are deleted from the State Flexible Education Funds program. The amount in the Flexible Education Funds program is reduced by \$834,000 and the allocation rate is reduced from \$36.00 per student to \$35.12 per student.

The cost of the amendment is \$278,000 general fund-state.
