**Partial Veto Summary:** The Governor vetoed provisions affecting the following state agencies: State Auditor, Department of Social and Health Services Juvenile Rehabilitation Program, Department of Labor and Industries, Department of Ecology, State Parks and Recreation Commission, Department of Natural Resources, State Patrol, Superintendent of Public Instruction, and the State Board for Community and Technical Colleges. The vetoes affect \$3.646 million of state General Fund appropriations.
