1 AN ACT Relating to membership on the higher education coordinating
2 board; and amending RCW 28B.80.380.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.80.380 and 1985 c 370 s 9 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 ~~((The board shall establish advisory committees composed of members
7 representing faculty, administrators, students, regents and trustees,
8 and staff of the public institutions, the superintendent of public
9 instruction, and the independent institutions.))~~ (1) The board shall
10 establish an advisory council consisting of: The superintendent of
11 public instruction; a representative of the two-year system of the
12 state board for community and technical colleges appointed by the state
13 board for community and technical colleges; one representative of the
14 research universities appointed by the president of the University of
15 Washington and the president of Washington State University; a
16 representative of the regional universities and The Evergreen State
17 College appointed through a process developed by the council of
18 presidents; a representative of the faculty for the four-year
19 institutions appointed by the council of faculty representatives; a

1 representative of the proprietary schools appointed by the federation
2 of private career schools and colleges; a representative of the
3 independent colleges appointed by the independent colleges of
4 Washington; and a faculty member in the community and technical college
5 system appointed by the state board for community and technical
6 colleges.

7 (2) The members of the advisory council shall each service a two-
8 year term except for the superintendent of public instruction, whose
9 term is concurrent with his or her term of office.

10 (3) The board shall meet with the advisory council at least
11 quarterly and shall seek advice from the council regarding the board's
12 discharge of its statutory responsibilities.
