1 AN ACT Relating to record checks for developmental disabilities
2 service providers; and adding a new section to chapter 71A.12 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 71A.12 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 All persons who provide services under this chapter and who will
7 have unsupervised access to persons with developmental disabilities are
8 required to submit to a record check through the Washington state
9 patrol criminal identification system under RCW 43.43.830 through
10 43.43.834, 10.97.030, and 10.97.050, and through the federal bureau of
11 investigation. The record check shall include a fingerprint check
12 using a complete Washington state criminal identification fingerprint
13 card. The requesting entity shall provide a copy of the record report
14 to the applicant. When necessary, persons may be employed on a
15 conditional basis pending completion of the investigation. If the
16 applicant has had a record check within the previous two years, the
17 agency may waive the requirement.
