- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.190 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The superintendent of public instruction shall submit to each 8 regular session of the legislature during an odd-numbered year a budget 9 request for residential education.
- 10 (2) The superintendent of public instruction shall allocate funding 11 appropriated by the legislature for residential education to the school 12 districts and educational service districts that are required to 13 conduct a program under this chapter and under RCW 13.04.145.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 28A.190 RCW to read as follows:
- Beginning with the 2009-10 school year, for those school districts
- 17 or educational service districts that provide instruction to students
- 18 in state detention facilities under RCW 28A.190.010 or in county

- juvenile detention facilities under RCW 13.04.145, each such district's
- 2 allocations attributable to those facilities must be based on
- 3 enrollment that is the greater of the current school year's enrollment
