1 AN ACT Relating to local improvement districts and utility local
2 improvement districts comprised of property in more than one city or
3 town; amending RCW 35.43.030; and declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 35.43.030 and 1971 ex.s. c 116 s 4 are each amended to
6 read as follows:

7 This and the following chapters relating to municipal local
8 improvements shall supersede the provisions of the charter of any city
9 of the first class.

10 They shall apply to all incorporated cities and towns, including
11 unclassified cities and towns operating under special charters.

12 The council of each city and town shall pass such general ordinance
13 or ordinances as may be necessary to carry out their provisions and
14 thereafter all proceedings relating to local improvements shall be
15 conducted in accordance with this and the following chapters relating
16 to municipal local improvements and the ordinance or ordinances of such
17 city or town.

18 Cities or towns may form local improvement districts or utility
19 local improvement districts composed entirely or in part of

1 unincorporated territory outside of such city or town's corporate
2 limits in the manner provided in this chapter, or, upon approval of the
3 legislative authority of an adjoining city or town, may form local
4 improvement districts or utility local improvement districts for
5 transportation and infrastructure purposes that are composed entirely
6 or in part of territory within that adjoining city or town.

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
9 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
10 immediately.

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
