
SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 2433

1 AN ACT Relating to compliance with federal selective service
2 requirements before the issuance of drivers' licenses and identicards;
3 adding a new section to chapter 46.20 RCW; creating a new section; and
4 providing an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.20 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 (1) Any person who is a male citizen or noncitizen of the United
9 States, who applies for an original, the renewal of, or a replacement
10 instruction permit, intermediate license, driver's license, or
11 identicard under this chapter, and who is under the age of twenty-six,
12 must be given the opportunity to register as required by the military
13 selective service act (62 Stat. 604; 50 App. U.S.C. Sec. 451 et seq.),
14 as amended.

15 (2) The submission of an application by an applicant under
16 subsection (1) of this section indicates that:

17 (a) The applicant has already registered with the selective service
18 system;

1 (b) The applicant authorizes the department to forward to the
2 selective service system the necessary personal information required
3 for registration into the system; or

4 (c) The applicant declines registration for purposes of the
5 military selective service act (62 Stat. 604; 50 App. U.S.C. Sec. 451
6 et seq.), as amended, in conjunction with the submission of an
7 application under subsection (1) of this section.

8 (3)(a) The department shall forward electronically any necessary
9 personal information of the applicant to the selective service system
10 within ten days of receipt of the application, as authorized under
11 subsection (2)(b) of this section.

12 (b) When applicable, the department shall notify the applicant at
13 the time of application submission that, by submitting the application,
14 the applicant authorizes the department to register the applicant with
15 the selective service system. If the applicant is under the age of
16 eighteen at the time of application, the department shall notify the
17 applicant that he will be registered with the selective service system
18 as required by federal law. When providing notice under this
19 subsection (3)(b), the department shall provide the applicant with
20 materials containing the following statement:

21 "By submitting this application, I am consenting to registration
22 with the Selective Service System, if so required by federal law. If
23 under age 18, I understand that I will be registered as required by
24 federal law when I attain age 18."

25 (4) The department may not deny the issuance of an instruction
26 permit, intermediate license, driver's license, or identicard if the
27 applicant declines to register with the selective service system,
28 provided that the applicant meets all other requirements of this
29 chapter.

30 (5) The department may provide selective service system
31 registration information to applicants who choose to decline the
32 opportunity to register with the selective service system.

33 (6) The department may adopt rules as necessary to implement this
34 section.

35 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** If specific funding for the purposes of this
36 act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by

1 June 30, 2010, in the omnibus transportation appropriations act, this
2 act is null and void.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** This act takes effect January 1, 2011.

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
