3 EFFECT: Creates a new Legislative Evaluation and Accountability
4 Program (LEAP) document, No. 2011-1D, which is a revised Public Works
5 Assistance Account ranked list of projects. The revised list adds
6 funding to the Bothell Crossroads Project and removes two projects and
7 a portion of funding from one project from the bottom of the original
8 list.

9 FISCAL IMPACT: There is no impact to the total appropriation, but
10 the allocation of the appropriation changes due to the addition of
11 resources to one project and deletion of other projects.
