- 1 AN ACT Relating to boatyard storm water treatment systems; and 2 amending RCW 90.58.355.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 90.58.355 and 1994 c 257 s 20 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- The procedural requirements of this chapter shall not apply to any person:
- 8 <u>(1) C</u>onducting a remedial action at a facility pursuant to a consent decree, order, or agreed order issued pursuant to chapter
- 10 70.105D RCW, or to the department of ecology when it conducts a
- 11 remedial action under chapter 70.105D RCW. The department ((of ecology
- $12 \quad \underline{\text{shall}})) \quad \underline{\text{must}} \quad \text{ensure compliance with the substantive requirements of}$
- 13 this chapter through the consent decree, order, or agreed order issued
- 14 pursuant to chapter 70.105D RCW, or during the department-conducted
- 15 remedial action, through the procedures developed by the department
- 16 pursuant to RCW 70.105D.090; or
- 17 (2) Installing site improvements for storm water treatment in an
- 18 <u>existing boatyard facility to meet requirements of a national pollutant</u>
- 19 <u>discharge elimination system storm water general permit. The</u>

- 1 <u>department must ensure compliance with the substantive requirements of</u>
- 2 this chapter through the review of engineering reports, site plans, and
