1 AN ACT Relating to boatyard storm water treatment systems; and
2 amending RCW 90.58.355.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 90.58.355 and 1994 c 257 s 20 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (~~The procedural requirements of this chapter~~) Requirements to
7 obtain a substantial development permit, conditional use permit, or
8 variance shall not apply to any person:

9 (1) Conducting a remedial action at a facility pursuant to a
10 consent decree, order, or agreed order issued pursuant to chapter
11 70.105D RCW, or to the department of ecology when it conducts a
12 remedial action under chapter 70.105D RCW. The department (~~of ecology~~
13 shall)) must ensure compliance with the substantive requirements of
14 this chapter through the consent decree, order, or agreed order issued
15 pursuant to chapter 70.105D RCW, or during the department-conducted
16 remedial action, through the procedures developed by the department
17 pursuant to RCW 70.105D.090; or

18 (2) Installing site improvements for storm water treatment in an
19 existing boatyard facility to meet requirements of a national pollutant

1 discharge elimination system storm water general permit. The
2 department must ensure compliance with the substantive requirements of
3 this chapter through the review of engineering reports, site plans, and
4 other documents related to the installation of boatyard storm water
5 treatment facilities.

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
