1 WHEREAS, It is of paramount importance to establish cutoff dates
2 for the consideration of legislation during the 2011 Regular Session of
3 the Sixty-Second Legislature;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of
5 the State of Washington, the Senate concurring, That the following
6 cutoff dates apply to all bills, memorials, and joint resolutions with
7 the exception of budgets, matters necessary to implement budgets,
8 initiatives to the legislature, and alternatives to initiatives to the
9 legislature:

10 (1) Monday, February 21, 2011, the forty-third day, will be the
11 final day to read in committee reports in the house of origin, with the
12 exception of reports from the Senate Ways and Means, Senate
13 Transportation, and House of Representatives fiscal committees;

14 (2) Friday, February 25, 2011, the forty-seventh day, will be the
15 final day to read in Senate Ways and Means, Senate Transportation, and
16 House of Representatives fiscal committee reports in the house of
17 origin;

18 (3) Monday, March 7, 2011, the fifty-seventh day, at 5:00 p.m.,
19 will be the final time to consider bills in their house of origin;

1 (4) Friday, March 25, 2011, the seventy-fifth day, will be the
2 final day to read in committee reports on bills from the opposite house
3 with the exception of reports from the Senate Ways and Means, Senate
4 Transportation, and House of Representatives fiscal committees;

5 (5) Friday, April 1, 2011, the eighty-second day, will be the final
6 day to read in Senate Ways and Means, Senate Transportation, and House
7 of Representatives fiscal committee reports on bills from the opposite
8 house; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That after 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 12,
10 2011, the ninety-third day, neither house may consider any bills,
11 memorials, or joint resolutions except initiatives to the legislature
12 and alternatives to such initiatives, budgets and matters necessary to
13 implement budgets, messages pertaining to amendments, matters of
14 differences between the two houses, and matters incident to the interim
15 and to the closing of the business of the 2011 Regular Session of the
16 Legislature.
