1 AN ACT Relating to the sentencing or imposition of conditions for
2 certain prostitution and sex crimes; amending RCW 9A.88.130; and
3 prescribing penalties.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.88.130 and 1999 c 327 s 2 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 (1)(a) When sentencing or imposing conditions on a person convicted
8 of, or receiving a deferred sentence or deferred prosecution for,
9 violating RCW 9A.88.030, 9A.88.110, or 9.68A.100, the court must impose
10 a requirement that the offender:

11 ~~((a))~~ (i) Not be subsequently arrested for prostitution,
12 patronizing a prostitute, or ~~((patronizing a juvenile prostitute))~~
13 commercial sexual abuse of a minor; and

14 ~~((b))~~ (ii) Remain outside ~~((the geographical area, prescribed by~~
15 ~~the court, in which the person was arrested for violating RCW 9A.88.110~~
16 ~~or 9.68A.100))~~ any areas designated under (b) of this subsection,
17 unless such a requirement would interfere with the person's legitimate
18 employment or residence or otherwise be infeasible.

1 (b) A person may be charged and subject to arrest if he or she has
2 been previously charged or convicted of any of the offenses listed in
3 this subsection and his or her sentence for the previous offense
4 requires the individual to stay out of an area designated by a local
5 governing authority as an area of increased prostitution activity.
6 Each local governing authority shall post signs at the boundaries of
7 each designated area of increased prostitution activity.

8 (2) ~~((This))~~ The requirements ~~((is))~~ in subsection (1) of this
9 section are in addition to the penalties set forth in RCW 9A.88.110,
10 9A.88.120, and 9.68A.100.

11 (3) A violation of subsection (1) of this section is a misdemeanor.
