- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.101 RCW to read as follows:
  - (1) The criminal justice training commission and the Washington state patrol shall ensure that issues related to motorcycle profiling are addressed in basic law enforcement training and offered to inservice law enforcement officers in conjunction with existing training regarding profiling.
- 11 (2) State and local law enforcement agencies shall add a statement 12 condemning motorcycle profiling to existing policies regarding 13 profiling.
- (3) For the purposes of this section, "motorcycle profiling" means using solely the fact that a person is riding a motorcycle or is wearing certain motorcycle-related paraphernalia while riding a motorcycle as a pretext in deciding whether or not to stop, detain,
