House Bills

HB 2129-S by House Committee on Ways & Means (originally sponsored by Representatives Haigh and Hunter; by request of Office of Financial Management)

Delaying apportionments to school districts for the 2012-13 school year.

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Delays apportionments to school districts for the 2012-2013 school year.

Provides that the act is null and void if certain funding for a financial contingency fund is not provided by June 30, 2012.

HB 2799-S by House Committee on Education (originally sponsored by Representatives Sullivan, Santos, Maxwell, Darneille, Hunt, Carlyle, Haigh, Pollet, and Kenney; by request of Governor Gregoire)

Authorizing a five-year pilot project for up to six collaborative schools for innovation and success operated by school districts in partnership with colleges of education.

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Creates the collaborative schools for innovation and success pilot project for colleges of education and school districts to collaborate to improve student and educator success.

Expires June 30, 2019.
