1 AN ACT Relating to calculation and allocation of appropriations for  
2 alternative learning experience courses; and amending RCW 28A.232.020.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.232.020 and 2013 2nd sp.s. c 18 s 503 are each  
5 amended to read as follows:

6 The superintendent of public instruction shall separately calculate  
7 and allocate moneys appropriated under RCW 28A.150.260 to school  
8 districts for each full-time equivalent student enrolled in an  
9 alternative learning experience course. The calculation shall be based  
10 on the estimated statewide annual average allocation per full-time  
11 equivalent student in grades nine through twelve in general  
12 education(~~(, excluding)~~). For students enrolled in approved career and  
13 technical education courses, the calculation shall be based on the  
14 estimated statewide annual average allocation per full-time equivalent  
15 student in grades nine through twelve in career and technical  
16 education. These calculations exclude small high school enhancements,  
17 and (~~including~~) include applicable rules and provisions of the

1 omnibus appropriations act.
