1 AN ACT Relating to electric personal assistive mobility devices;
2 amending RCW 46.04.1695; and providing an effective date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.04.1695 and 2002 c 247 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 "Electric personal assistive mobility device" (EPAMD) means a self-
7 balancing device with one wheel or two wheels not in tandem, designed
8 to transport only one person by an electric propulsion system with an
9 average power of seven hundred fifty watts (one horsepower) if two-
10 wheeled or two thousand watts (two and two-thirds horsepower) if one-
11 wheeled, having a maximum speed on a paved level surface, when powered
12 solely by such a propulsion system while ridden by an operator weighing
13 one hundred seventy pounds, of less than twenty miles per hour.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect July 1, 2014.
