- 1 AN ACT Relating to licensing standards for before and after-school
- 2 programs; amending RCW 43.215.210; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.215.210 and 2006 c 265 s 302 are each amended to read as follows:
  - The chief of the Washington state patrol, through the director of fire protection, shall have the power and it shall be his or her duty:
  - (1) In consultation with the director and with the advice and assistance of persons representative of the various type agencies to be licensed, to adopt recognized minimum standard requirements pertaining to each category of agency established pursuant to this chapter necessary to protect all persons residing therein from fire hazards;
- 13 (2) To adopt licensing minimum standard requirements to allow
  14 children who attend classes in a school building during school hours to
  15 remain in the same building to participate in before-school or after16 school programs and to allow participation in such before-school and

((4))) (5) To issue to applicants for licenses under this chapter who comply with the requirements, a certificate of compliance, a copy of which shall be presented to the department before a license shall be issued, except that an initial license may be issued as provided in RCW 43.215.280.

11 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The chief of the Washington state patrol, 12 through the director of fire protection, shall have the power and it 13 shall be his or her duty to adopt licensing minimum standard 14 requirements for before-school and after-school programs in existing 15 buildings approved by the state fire marshal.
